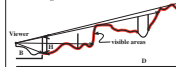
### Social Overlay

The composite map was generated by "adding" a visual analysis from surrounding homes and a 100 meter buffer from adjacent neighborhoods. Area within the 100 meter buffer were assigned a value of 3 while the visual analysis was divided into 4 categories of low visibility (1), moderate visibility (2), moderately high visibility (3) and high visibility (4). The visual analysis used a viewer height of 20 feet above local terrain, a tree height of 40 feet and a building height of 24 feet (see Line-of-Sight diagram).
